FAMILY-, FRIEND-, TOURIST-, BUSINESS- OR TRANSIT-VISA

Anyone is entitled to apply for a visa. The handling fee is not refundable even if visa is not granted.. A complete set of documentation does not mean that a visa automatically will be granted. Note: you must apply for a visa at the Embassy/Consulate representing the country where your main destination is. You must present yourself at the Embassy/Consulate when submitting the following documents:

Please check the boxes below and sign to confirm which documents you have submitted:

- Application form filled in using BLOCKLETTERS correctly and duly completed and signed with 2 passport photos (colour size 3,5 by 4,5) not older than 3 months.
Original Passport valid for three months exceeding the date of return to K.S.A(Travel document must be valid for six month.....)
Copy of passport with relevant pages of the passport, Place and date of issue, expiration date, previous visas, valid resident/work permit etc.
Letter from employer confirming the applicants employment. (position/job title, level of income, date of first employment and date for termination of contract). Arabic letters should be translated by an authorized translator.
Documents proving sustainable economic means or income of the applicant.
Alternatively, if the above can not be submitted or are insufficient, the following must be submitted:
Original guarantee form (issued by the guarantor) for visits-stamped by Norwegian authorities +1 copi
Proof of minimum income of NOK 178.000 pr. year of the guarantor (as of 1 May 2006)
Last available tax receipt
Three last payslips
This documentation must be send by regular or express mail directly to the applicant to avoid froudulent documentation
Confirmed travel reservations (booking) of roundtrip air ticket, with fixed travel dates of maximum 90 days. Do NOT buy the ticket until visa has been granted. Note: If the visa application is approved, the visa will be issued according to the dates on the booking and the compulsory health insurance.
Compulsory travel medical insurance, covering all Schengen countries, the whole period of stay and for a minimum of 30,000 Euro, should be submitted with the application.

Make sure that the dates of the invitations and reservations match and that the insurance covers the necessary number of days.

- If you are under 18, you must submit:
- If you are travelling alone: An original and a copy of letter of consent signed by both parents
- If you are travelling with only one of your parents: An original and a copy of letter of consent from the other parent
- If the parent you are travelling with has single custody: A shown original and a copy of certificate of single custody
Please contact the Embassy about special rules for minors under 18 years intending to visit parent living in Norway (UDI circular 2004-018 OPA).
Optional for applicants who want the reference or other to represent in the case: Letter of trust/proxy
Separate form is obtainable at the Embassy
